

ST. MARTIN DE PORRES HIGH SCHOOL OVERVIEW

Catholic coeducational college preparatory high school

- Founded in 2004
- Open to students of all faiths and cultures (81% Catholic, 19% Other)
- Faith based education in an atmosphere of mutual respect for all religions and cultural differences
- College preparatory curriculum for all students

Established to serve Lake County disadvantaged students

- Restrictions on household income level
- Average yearly income for a SMdP family of four is \$35,500

81% Latino

13% African American

4% Caucasian

1% Multi-racial

1% Asian

Education made affordable through unique Corporate Internship Program with Lake County businesses and Annual Fund-Raising activities

- All students work five full business days per month in entry level clerical jobs
- Academic schedules are structured so students do not miss instructional time
- Cost of Education per student: 2005-06 - \$14,400
- Cost of Education per student: 2006-07 - \$12,337.63
- Cost of Education per student: 2007-08 - \$11,580
- Students earn \$6,250 towards their education from Corporate Partner Internship Program
- Student tuition - \$2,500
- 71% of the current student body receive financial assistance
- Total financial assistance required: \$220,000
- Students learn to be adaptable, accountable and responsible

Estimated costs of facility renovation - \$900,000

Estimated costs of science/computer Modular addition - \$425,000
